## **A** DANGER

To reduce the risk of electric shock or injury:

- Use indoors only.
- Always unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning.

## **A WARNING**

- Use on flat surfaces only. Bed may tip over on uneven surfaces.
- Remove all sharp objects from area where bed will be set up and used. Do not use this bed on abrasive surfaces or near pointed/sharp items or surfaces. Bed may puncture.
- If the bed is very cold, allow it to warm up to room temperature before inflating.
- Product is for indoor use only. Do not use outdoors. For Household/Residential Use Only.

WARNING: Read airbed instruction manual and follow all safety instructions to avoid serious injury or death.

## Risk of Suffocation

- Infants have suffocated on inflatable mattresses. Never allow a child under 3 years of age or persons with limited mobility to sleep on an inflatable mattress.
- Children can be entrapped between the inflatable mattress and an adjacent vertical surface. Provide at least a shoulder width space between the inflatable mattress and walls, dressers or other vertical objects to avoid entrapment
- Always keep the inflatable mattress fully inflated when in use.

### INFLATION

## NOTE: BED MUST BE AT ROOM TEMPERATURE PRIOR TO INFLATING OR IT MAY CAUSE AIR LEAKS.

- 1. Place your rolled-up bed on the floor or other surface free of obstructions or sharp objects
- 2. Before inflation, locate valve at end of bed. Remove valve cap by twisting counter-clockwise. Make sure the flapper inside the valve is not locked in the open position. If ves. pull the red bar firmly to release flapper from a locked-open position (Fig. A).
- 3. Remove AC pump and cord from protective plastic shipping wraps.
- 4. Plug into any standard polarized 120 Volt AC electrical outlet. North American Electrical rating: 120 VAC 60 Hz 1.25 A (Note: 230 VAC product sold outside of North America). To reduce the risk of electric shock, this furnishing has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other (Fig. B), This plug will fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician to install the proper outlet. Do not change

the plug in any way. Never use with an extension cord unless the plug can be fully inserted. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature.

- 5. Insert inflate nozzle of handheld pump into valve opening and press switch to turn on pump. (Note: An adapter nozzle is not required to inflate bed) (Fig. C).
- 6. A high pitch whine of the pump will signal the bed is inflated to full (firmest) capacity. Bed will not over-
- 7. When fully inflated, remove pump and twist (clockwise) the cap back onto the valve.

## **DEFLATION AND STORAGE**

- 1. Open the valve cap and push the flapper inside the valve open to the lock position to release the air (Fig. D).
- 2. For most compact storage, attach adapter to deflate nozzle of pump. Insert pump adapter into valve opening and turn on pump (Fig. E). Turn off pump when bed is fully deflated.
- 3. Fold sides of bed into the center along its length (Fig. F). Tightly roll your bed towards the air release valve.
- 4. Roll the bed completely until all air is expelled. When the bed is completely rolled, twist the cap clockwise to close the valve. Place the bed in the convenient carry bag or other storage solution and store in a dry, clean location.


### CARE AND MAINTENANCE


- 1. Inspect your bed prior to each use.
- 2. Keep your bed away from any sharp objects or obstacles with rough edges. Large cuts or snags may not be repairable and will not be covered by your bed warranty.
- 3. We recommend that you do not let the plush surface of your AeroBed® mattress get wet. Repeated exposure to water or other liquids may cause damage to the plush surface that will not be covered by your warranty. Should liquid come in contact with the plush surface, blot liquid dry and use a damp cloth to remove any stain. Let surface air dry
- 4. You may clean the PVC on the sides and bottom of your bed with a mild dishwashing detergent or household cleaner. Do not use strong chemicals or other compounds. Allow your bed to air dry completely after cleaning and before storing.












Deflating - Push flapper valve onen into locked position
