

Q: What size windshield does the FrostGuard® Windshield Cover fit?

A: FrostGuard comes in two sizes: Standard and X-Large, to protect the essential viewing area of most cars, trucks and SUVs from frost, ice or snow.

- Standard measures 61" wide x 41" long
- X-Large measures 70" wide x 41" long

The width is measured across the seam of the wiper cover, on the outside of the dowels.

Q: What size should I buy for my vehicle?

A: We recommend using the FrostGuard sizing charts to find the best size for your vehicle type.

- Standard is recommended for Compact Cars, Sedans, Small Crossovers and Small SUVs.
- X-Large is recommended for Minivans, Medium and Large SUVs, and Large Pickup Trucks.

Buying too large a size can result in a loose fit. This can lead to less protection for your vehicle, as it allows for elements such as moisture and wind to come in contact with your windshield.

Q: How does it fit vehicles of different sizes?

A: FrostGuard's Fit-Fast® attachment system is a 3-loop elastic system that allows for an adjustable fit. The Fit-Fast system secures the windshield cover to the side-view mirrors on either side of the vehicle. Our patent pending design will accommodate mirror sizes of both older and newer vehicles, big and small.

Q: How do I install my FrostGuard Windshield Cover?

A: We recommend these simple steps:

- Place it on your windshield and open the passenger door and insert the security panel.
- Choose the elastic loop that will best fit over your vehicle's mirrors and loop it over your passenger's side-view mirror.
- Unroll it as you walk around the front of your vehicle to the driver's door.
- Lightly tug on the cover to ensure it is centered and flat against your windshield.
- Open the driver's side door and slide the security panel into your car.
- Slide the elastic loop over opposite side-view mirror.
- Ensure the wiper cover is laying over your covers for added protection.

Note: A little bit of exposed windshield is normal.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Will the Mirror Covers accommodate oversized mirrors?

A: X-Large Mirror Covers are compatible with regular and oversized (towing) mirrors found on most light trucks. However, the product is not recommended for heavy commercial vehicles, such as semi-trucks and school buses.

Q: How do I install the mirror covers?

A: We recommend these simple steps:

- Choose the Mirror Cover with the logo facing you and with the opening on the right-hand side.
- Slide the cover over the driver's side-view mirror and adjust the drawstring to secure the unit in place.
- Select the second mirror cover and repeat on the passenger's side-view mirror.

Note: The FrostGuard logo will face the rear of your vehicle when the mirror covers have been installed correctly.

Q: Do I have to use the mirror covers?

A: No, Mirror Covers are completely optional. They are included to give your side-view mirrors the same protection from frost, snow, and ice as your FrostGuard Windshield Cover.

Q: Can the FrostGuard be used on the back windshield of my vehicle?

A: The product is designed for use on the front windshield only.

Q: How do I protect from wind getting underneath my FrostGuard?

A: Always choose the loop pairings that provide the most secure fit against the front of your windshield. The fit should be taught and flat. This will prevent sudden gusts of wind from getting underneath your FrostGuard Windshield Cover.

Q: What is the best way to clean my FrostGuard?

A: Spot-clean with soap and cold water.

Q: Can the FrostGuard be used as a sunshield?

A: The FrostGuard is designed to block frost, snow and ice in cold weather. It should not be used as a sunshade or in extremely hot weather.
