AWARD WINNING HYDRANGEA MISS SAORI

This award-winning shrub is a showy addition to the garden. The fully double white blooms are liberally frosted with a soft, rosy-pink edging. With a medium to fast growth rate and long flowering period that begins in June and lasts through fall, it makes an outstanding focal point or border planting. Large mophead-type flower clusters look fantastic in a cut-flower arrangement or bouquet, too. Lures beneficial pollinators to the garden. Unlike many hydrangeas, this variety will remain the same color, regardless of soil type.

Quick Tips

- The product we have sent to you was packaged in either wood chips or peat moss. This is done to ensure that the product arrives fresh and healthy.
- The products you ordered are living plants. There will be some size variance between each item in your package.
- These items have been measured and graded prior to shipping. You are receiving the highest quality product.

QUICK REFERENCE PLANTING GUIDE

LIGHT/SUN EXPOSURE	Full Sun - Partial Shade
USDA HARDINESS ZONES	Zones 5-11
SPACING BETWEEN PLANTS	36-48"
MATURE HEIGHT/SPREAD	36-48" / 36-48"
BLOOM TIME	Summer - Fall

SOIL PREPARATION

Although all of these items do well in average, well-drained soil of all types, for optimum results you can improve your planting success as follows:

- 1 Spade or rototill the soil to a depth of 12".
- 2 It's always good to add organic matter to your soil. You can mix in a 2-4" layer of dehydrated manure, garden compost, shredded leaves and/or peat moss.

PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

Dig a hole large enough to accommodate the roots. Spread roots around and fill in with dirt so that the crown is at soil level. Firm soil around plant and water thoroughly.

This product was shipped to you at the proper planting time. However, sometimes Mother Nature will bring in an unexpected cold front. The product should be planted when the average high temperature is around 60°F and the low temperature does not drop down below 40°F.



CONTINUING CARE

WATERING

Water well. Keep soil moist but not soggy.

MULCHING

Apply a 2-4" layer of mulch to promote moisture retention and maintain even garden soil temperatures.

WEEDING

Keep the area around your plants free of weeds. Weeds compete with all plants for food, water and light. Walk around the garden periodically and pull weeds.

GROOMING

Prune as necessary to maintain shape after flowering.

FEEDING

Discontinue any foliar or liquid feed by early September. Your plants want to harden off for winter dormancy.

WINTERIZING

Mulch the first winter after planted.
